

"Hello everybody, we are sending greetings from Rojava !

From Rojava we will follow what will be happening on the streets today. This is very important and you have to know that, here we are following the news on TV, Twitter, facebook, radio, and we see what is happening in the world. Rojava shall not be left alone, Rojava shall not fight on its own. The revolutionary processes that are happening here are not only being defended by the population.

All of us who long for a deep change of the existing system must stand side by side and defend this project. Don't stay passive because of inner contradictions, questions and critiques. Express them, debate with one another, come over here, to Rojava, and learn how processes are working here, how difficult they can be sometimes. But you must know that everybody here is ready to defend the revolutionary transformations here in Rojava. Nobody here wants to leave.

Many are afraid, of course. Mothers fear for their children. Many cannot fight because they are hurt, because they are weak, because they are scared. This is all part of a common, broad front of resistance, and everyone finds his or her place in it. The mothers are looking for safe places for their children so they don't start their life traumatized. They organize so they can also defend their neighbourhood with a weapon in the hand. They try to be part of the resistance, and at the same time to protect their children, so they can grow up in a different world. This is very impressive when you talk to these women. And these women are a very strong part of the revolution. Not only those who are fighting on the frontline within the fighting units. I mean every single woman here, in the civil society, who organizes within their neighbourhoods so their children can survive and have a positive look on the world. And this resistance is growing stronger.

But we also know that it's a difficult situation which is not easy to resolve. We know that we have a fascist NATO state as an enemy, which is very powerful, especially if it can use the airspace for attacks. And this is of course a difficult situation. [...] Ground operations and city fights are different, they can be fought and pushed back through tough struggles. These struggles are being fought by the Kurdish, Arab, Assyrians, Yazidis and all kind of fighters. There are also many internationalists who fight side by side to defend a project they are helping to build up. [...] The complexity is also that the enemy is inside: the Daesh fighters in the prisons who are trying to escape and who form combat cells which attack Raqqa again. Daesh is an important factor, an inner war frontline. [...]

The Daesh women in Al Hol camp are waiting for an upheaval so they can fight against this revolutionary, emancipatory, progressive society. These places are extremely dangerous, and nobody in the world wants to take responsibility for this situation. Rojava is left alone with this, even though there are many international former Daesh fighters in the camp. [...]

We are worried, but we are optimistic, because we have a big strength here. The fighters have been fighting back many attacks. They manage to push back the enemy even when they sometimes take a village.

This resistance must be supported with international solidarity ! When the international solidarity is strong, when we see that the people around the world fight with us, the people here see it on the TVs that are running everywhere and they won't feel alone. They will feel that we are fighting all together, side by side.

The USA, the imperialist forces always have big words and coalitions, but people here know, this is only diplomacy. These are not friends who share their struggle, and people here know that. [...] Show solidarity, take the streets, show your anger, how- and wherever you are ! [...]

We greet you from Rojava, we know that we will walk this path together. Take care, be strong, enjoy the togetherness on the streets. Fighting for a common goal has strength and beauty. It is a fire that is lit within our hearts, let's share it and fight together this tough but real struggle for a new society, for a revolutionary process!
